MD 295 Triple Bridges Project News

Fall 2019

Baltimore City DOT and the Project Team hope everyone had a great Summer! Please read on to learn about the progress that was made on the project over the past few months, as well as some upcoming activities to be aware of. ANNAPOLIS ROAD BRIDGE DEMOLITION AND RECONSTRUCTION

In order to expedite the project and provide safer conditions for drivers passing under the bridge while it's being replaced, the project team implemented a successful complete closure of MD 295 the weekend of April 26-29, 2019 to demolish the existing bridge. A thick layer of sand was poured over MD 295 to protect the roadway from falling pieces of the bridge. The team worked day and night to demolish the bridge, clean up, and reopen MD 295 before the Monday rush hour began. Foundation work on the new bridge is underway now and you will see it rising soon.

WATERVIEW AVENUE BRIDGE

On September 20, 2019, the Waterview Avenue Bridge will be taken down to one lane in each direction with new temporary signals in place for vehicular traffic. This is in preparation for the work to follow in October 2019 that will close the entire north side of the Waterview Avenue Bridge for total demolition and reconstruction. Once the full closure is in place, the sidewalk across the bridge will no longer be available to pedestrians. The nearby Maisel Street pedestrian bridge will become the primary on-foot detour. In advance of the lane closure, you will notice signage and a temporary traffic signal being installed.
