


What is Visualize 2045?

- → A new kind of long-range transportation plan. Visualize 2045 will show the projects and improvements the region's transportation agencies are planning through 2045—both what they can afford now and what they would build if they had more funding.
- Multimodal solutions for a complex, growing region. The plan will include road, transit, bicycle, and pedestrian improvements, recognizing that no one travel mode will accommodate future population growth and address the region's diverse transportation challenges.
- → A tool for visualizing the region's future. The plan will paint a picture of where the region's current planning and funding decisions will get us so that we might better understand the kinds of decisions we need to make today to realize a more desirable transportation future.

Visualize 2045 is being developed by the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board, the federally designated metropolitan planning organization for metropolitan Washington.
